Dear Parents/Carers,

Ashchurch Rural Parish Council (ARPC) is proud of its longstanding working relationship with Ashchurch Primary School and the mutual support between us.

ARPC are currently implementing a Community Speedwatch Campaign as part of a multi-pronged attack to take control of parish roads! The A46 extremes of speeding and queueing is a huge issue we are trying to tackle and understand this has a massive impact on parents and children. We are liaising with National Highways regarding traffic queues to ensure traffic lights in the industrial areas are not causing unsatisfactory tailbacks through Ashchurch and beyond. We are also raising awareness and pressurising Tewkesbury Borough Council and National Highways into addressing the extremely dangerous A46 crossing situation at Barleyfields, as we wholeheartedly believe there should be a pedestrian crossing here.

Therefore, we are reaching out to the local community to support these efforts and invite the children to help highlight concerns with some creative posters. The overall winning poster will be printed in our newsletters and used on the ARPC Facebook and website to help promote our road safety campaigns. In reward, we are offering some great prizes which we hope will inspire some great pieces of work! The posters should be on A4 paper and include (on the back) the child's name, class and preferred voucher. This could be anything from book tokens to Smyth's vouchers - as long as you are happy for them to win it, we are happy to provide it! Posters can either be posted into the new post box on the front of the Village Hall or given to a teacher for us to collect. Closing Date Friday 3 March 2023.

All entries will be displayed and winners will be announced at our upcoming Community Action Event at Ashchurch Village Hall on Saturday 11 March 2023.

ARPC has organised this interactive event to provide the community with news of upcoming developments in the parish as well as receive feedback with regards to issues that matter to the community. More information will follow.
